Complete Application Deadline: January 2nd, 2024

Hoag's Pharmacy Practice Residency (PGY1) program has been fully accredited by the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists (ASHP). The program builds on the Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists. Residents will be responsible for medication-related care of patients with a range of conditions, and eligible for board certification and PGY2 pharmacy residency training.

Note: This residency program is participating in the PhORCAS (Pharmacy Online Residency Centralized Application Service) system. Applications completed outside of PhORCAS will not be accepted. All applicants must be registered in the ASHP Residency Matching Program [and have a unique National Matching Services (NMS) code].

Please submit the standardized application materials as required by PhORCAS, including:

- 1. Basic Demographics
- 2. Official Transcripts
- 3. Personal Statement/Letter of Intent (stating your reasons for applying, specific to Hoag's Pharmacy Practice Residency Program)
- 4. Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 5. Three references using the standardized PhORCAS reference template, completed by healthcare professionals who can attest to your practice abilities and aptitudes. It is highly encouraged for them to provide specific narrative comments (limited to 6500 characters each box) regarding the nature of their interaction(s) with you, and your strengths and areas of improvement.

- 7. Submit a short video of yourself to pharmacyresidency@hoag.org that contains the following:
 - The video must contain you speaking
 - b. Introduce yourself say your full name and pharmacy school

 - d. Optional: You can choose to include anything else you would like us to know about you
 - e. Duration is 90 seconds or less. No more than 90 seconds please.
 - f. Email Subject: "Your Name (Your Pharmacy School) Residency Application Video"
